Each photograph needs to be labeled with the *category name and first and last name of the photographer*. Winners and runners-up will be contacted after the contest for high-resolution photographs. If the submitted photo(s) contain(s) clear and recognizable images of people in a privately-owned establishment, organization, or resident the photographer will need to have permission from that established organization or resident.
